If you are interested in civic engagement, social activism, political theatre, and the campaign finance debate, please know today (Thursday, November 5), during TASC, the Philosophy and Aesthetics and Ideas classes will be hosting Dixie and John Tymitz from Pittsburg, PA. John is a former university administrator and Dixie is a long-time actor and educator. For several years, they have been touring a one-woman show about former Dublin resident and social activist Doris Haddock ("Granny D"), who died at age 100 in 2010. On New Year's Day in 1999, Doris Haddock began a one-woman march for campaign finance reform that started in Pasadena, Calif., and ended on the steps of the Capitol in Washington 14 months later. "Granny D's" march garnered the interest of national media outlets and social pundits across the country, including the New York Times and Bill Moyers, as well as the bipartisan support of congressman like John McCain and Paul Wellstone (deceased). Dixie and John will present a 40-minute version of Dixie's show, starting at 10:20 AM sharp, and then stay for a discussion about her experiences touring and about the discussions she has had with people of all ages about campaign finance reform.
