Registering with Selective Service is a federal law and those who fail to register may be denied student loans, job training, government jobs, and driver's licenses in most state. Selective Service registration isn't the draft. There is no draft and hasn't been one for nearly 40 years. You can get a Selective Service registration card at your local post office or register online at www.sss.gov or see Mrs. Tieger in the Counseling Office.
