Dear Parents and Guardians,

This past week ...

- ... I heard from many parents and colleagues how impressed they are with the narratives that were shared on the third-quarter report cards. One parent shared that she truly appreciated the time and energy her son's teachers had put into providing him with specific feedback on what he had accomplished and where he could improve. Our teachers' efforts to provide authentic narrative feedback is truly exceptional.

The program honors academically talented public high school seniors who have demonstrated a commitment to community service.
