There will be a free SAT Prep Course offered for Juniors only beginning on Tuesday, February 2. The course will run on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:00-8:15pm for three weeks. Registration forms are available in the Main Office and the School Counseling Office. Contact Mr. Reitnauer with questions.

The Class of 2017 will be holding a Winter Dance on Saturday, February 6th from 7:00 – 10:00 PM in the Cafeteria. Tickets will only be available at the door. Cost is \$10.00 per person. The ASVAB will be offered on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 from 7:30 - 11:00 am at ConVal. Sign up in the Counseling Office. The ASVAB is a career planning and exploration program that combines a multiple-aptitude test with an interest self-assessment and a wide range of career exploration tools. It is offered free to any interested senior or junior in January at ConVal. The test combines an aptitude test (required for entrance to any military branch) with a career interest inventory. Following the test, representatives come to explain the results to students, and to help them match up with potential careers. The ASVAB is an excellent assessment for any student who is still unsure about their future career path, and, for those

interested in the military, it is good practice for the “real” ASVAB!

Driver Education Information

Students must have turned 16 by the end of the class. **The course costs \$625.00.
