Paula joined the Grapevine as a parent in 2006 with her first son. Paula began as a volunteer and later joined the staff working in the Better Beginnings program. It was during that time that she and co-worker Amy Doyle saw a need for an offsite parent/caregiver child playgroup in Hillsborough. "Amy and I wanted to start a program in Hillsborough, because this is our hometown community and it was important to us. We could see a need that wasn't being met." With community input, the Hillsborough Playgroup began in 2016 and continues to meet twice per week. The group gives children the opportunity to socialize and play, while parents and caregivers get time to connect with one another and relax. Paula also works with Amy in the Learning Vine Preschool, where nature meets the classroom in this outdoor based program. Paula shares, "Getting to know both the parent and the child provides a different view into the family. I'm lucky to have equal love for both parts of my job."
